

2011 BBS of America “Pole Award” and “Grand Award” Program

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- **BBS “Pole Award”** outlined below:
 - Competitors must meet all of the following requirements:
 - Competitors must display two(2) BBS decals (one on each side) of car during an event
 - Competitors must compete with the Factory Porsche Cup BBS wheels on the car
 - Awards will be presented as follows:
 - The fastest qualifying lap recorded by a competitor in both **Gold Cup** and **Platinum Cup** will be awarded a \$250 BBS certificate toward the purchase of any BBS product on the post-race podium for the first race of the event.
 - The fastest race lap recorded in the first race of the event by a competitor in both **Gold Cup** and **Platinum Cup** will be awarded a \$250 BBS certificate toward the purchase of any BBS product on the podium for the second race of the event.
 - Points awarded based on the following:
 - Top 10 Drivers from their fastest laps from qualifying and their fastest laps from the 1st race in both **Gold Cup** and **Platinum Cup** will receive points toward the year-end Grand Prize.
 - If Qualifying is cancelled, points will be awarded by the starting line up for both classes.
 - Points will be awarded as follows:

Place	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	10th
Points	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

It is Mandatory that each BBS Pole Award Driver from both classes be present at the post- race podium for that race or the Driver will not receive BBS Pole Award points for that race.

BBS “Pole Award Grand Prize” outlined below:

At the completion of the season, the Driver from the **Gold Cup** and the Driver from the **Platinum Cup** Classes with the most BBS Pole Award points accumulated during the 2010 BBS Pole Award season will be declared the winners for each class. The “BBS Pole Award Grand Prize” for each Driver will be a BBS Table Wheel with the drivers named etched in the glass or \$1500 BBS certificate toward the purchase of any BBS product.

In case of a tie, the Driver that won the most poles will be declared the winner, if there’s still a tie then the Driver with the most 2nd fastest times would win. This tie-breaker format will continue all the way to 10th place. If there’s still a tie, then the Drivers names will be drawn from a hat to determine the winner.
